Look for toys meeting F963, which has new provisions for components such as **batteries and magnets**.



Artist materials such as **paints and crayons** should be marked with D4236 and meet its labeling requirements for health hazards.



Choose **candles** marked with safety information according to F2058.



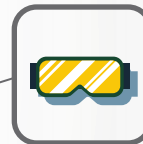
Children's and adult's **jewelry** that meets the requirements of F2923 or F2999, respectively, have safe levels of elements like lead.



Be sure that new equestrian **helmets sport** the ASTM and SEI logos, indicating they meet F1163 requirements and are certified by SEI for the best in protection.



Protect your paintball fan's eyes with **protective gear** meeting F1776.



Check that children's **scooters** meet F2264 for performance requirements, test methods, and labeling.
